ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

These Articles of Incorporation are signed and acknowledged by the incorporators for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of 1931, as amended, as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is The Allegan County Resource Development Committee, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

Sec. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

The purpose of the organization shall be to provide coordination, stimulation, financial, technical and administrative assistance to governmental units, public and private non-profit agencies in Allegan County in the development of the natural, human and economic resources to combat the causes and effects of human suffering and poverty.

Sec. 2.

- a. The implementation of programs under the provisions as set forth by the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-452).
- b. Research on the extent of causes and effects of poverty in the Allegan area.
- c. Development of dynamic and imaginative programs providing services, assistance and other activities of sufficient scope and size to give promise of progress toward eliminating poverty and.
- d. Coordination of appropriate existing local, State and Federal programs in a concentrated effort to alleviate poverty and develop the communities human resources.
- e. To accept, acquire, receive, take and hold by bequest, devise, grant, gift, purchase, exchange, lease, transfer, judicial order or decree, or otherwise, either absolutely or in trust, for any of its objects and purposes, any property, both real and personal, of whatever kind, nature or description and wherever situated.
- f. To sell, exchange, convey, mortgage, lease, transfer, or otherwise dispose of any such property, both real and personal as the objects and purposes of the corporation may require, subject to such limitations as may be prescribed by law.

CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

the Allegan County Resource Development Committee, Inc.
(Corporate Name)

a Michigan corporation, whose registered office is located at 227 Hubbard Street

Allegan Allegan Michigan 49010, certifies pursuant to the provisions of Section 43 of Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of 1931, as amended, that at a meeting of the Members
(Shareholders or members) of said corporation called for the purpose of amending the articles of incorporation, and held on the 21st day of April, 1966, it was resolved by the vote of { the holders of a majority of the shares }
~~{ the holders of two-thirds of the shares }~~ of each class entitled to vote and by { a majority of the shares }
~~{ two-thirds of the shares }~~ of each class whose rights, privileges or preferences are changed, that Article No. 11 of the Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows, viz.:

ARTICLE 11 PURPOSE

(Any article being amended is required to be set forth in its entirety.)

- SECTION 1. The purpose of the organization shall be to provide coordination, stimulation, financial, technical and administrative assistance to governmental units, public and private non-profit agencies in Allegan County in the development of the natural, human and economic resources to combat the causes and effects of human suffering and poverty.
- SECTION 2. a. The implementation of programs under the provisions as set forth by the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-452).
- b. Research on the extent of causes and effects of poverty in Allegan County.
- c. Development of dynamic and imaginative programs providing services, assistance and other activities of sufficient scope and size to give promise of progress toward eliminating poverty.
- d. Coordination of appropriate existing local, State and Federal programs in a concentrated effort to alleviate poverty and develop the communities human resources.
- e. To accept, acquire, receive, take and hold by bequest, devise, grant, gift, purchase,

exchange, lease, transfer, judicial order or decree, or otherwise, either absolutely or in trust, for any of its objects and purposes, any property, both real and personal, of

whatever kind, nature of description and wherever situated.

- f. To sell, exchange, convey, mortgage, lease, transfer, or otherwise dispose of any such property, both real and personal as the objects and purposes of the corporation may require, subject to such limitations as may be prescribed by law.
- g. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no member, trustee, officer of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.
- h. In the event of dissolution, all assets real and personal shall be distributed to such organizations as are qualified as tax exempt under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provisions of a future United States Internal Revenue Law.

NOTE: Sec. 43, amended by Act 155, P. A. 1953, provides:

"* * * * That any amendment which impairs the preemptive right of the holders of shares of any class of capital stock entitled to such right shall be approved by the vote of the holders of 2/3 of the shares of each such class. * * * *"
